## New Headteacher

I am delighted to be able to tell you that the recruitment process for the new Headteacher has now been finalised. Mr Bradley Young has been appointed as the Headteacher of the Ormesby Village Schools and we send our congratulations to him. He is currently a serving Norfolk Headteacher, so is highly experienced in senior school leadership. He will start working here on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021 and I will ensure that there is a smooth transfer over the course of the summer term. I am sure he will find time to come and visit the schools before he starts.

## Covid Track and Trace

As previously, we are required to support Covid Track and Trace when we break up for the Easter holiday. If your child displays Covid symptoms, and has a positive test at any time during the first 48 hours after Friday, you must inform class teachers on Class Dojo and we will determine whether we need to contact other individuals to self-isolate. Many thanks for following this guidance.

**Please also note that if your primary age child displays Covid symptoms, they must have a PCR Covid test, either at a test centre, or administered at home and then sent off for analysis.** They should not have a rapid lateral flow test and we have confirmed with the schools' DfE help line that we cannot accept a result from one of these tests. Many thanks for your co-operation with this regulation.

## Treat Friday

On Friday we are treating the children to some slices of pizza, freshly cooked on site by the Piazza Wheel Company, who have a wood fired pizza oven in their van! They will also enjoy an Easter egg hunt. They can come to school in their own clothes. Children will have their lunch as usual, at the normal time, but you might want to put a little less in packed lunches. This day is in celebration of the return to school, in anticipation of warmer weather and good things to come, and, above all, a thank you to your children for being so amazing and coping so well with the trials and tribulations of the last year!
