Dear Parents

As we approach what would have been the start of the Easter break I am writing to assure you all that you remain constantly in our thoughts and hearts. We fervently hope that you and your extended families and friends are well and continue to be so. We are very grateful for the enthusiasm with which you have engaged with home learning and I would like to thank you and the children for your hard work. I would also like to thank my staff for providing such a wide range of activities for the children and for keeping the school open for key workers as required. Please take note of the following points as we approach the Easter period.

- From Friday April 3rd to Friday April 17th the school office will be closed, so the telephones will not be answered. Office staff are taking their Easter break as they would have done in 'normal' times.
- Teachers will not be providing home learning between Thursday 2nd April and Friday 17th April as this would have been the Easter break. They will message you on Class Dojo/via the website about any optional Easter activities they may set and about their availability for individual messaging. Home learning will resume on Monday April 20th, the start of the summer term.
- If your personal circumstances change because of the coronavirus pandemic and you think your child might be eligible for the pupil premium, and consequently free school meals, do not hesitate to contact the school office at the start of the summer term. Staff will support you with an application if you now meet the criteria.

We have no information about when the schools might re-open, but, of course, we will inform you as soon as we receive any information. Currently we expect them to remain closed for the start of the summer term.

Please continue to look after your loved ones over the Easter break.
