### Pedestrian training/road safety

Y1 children completed pedestrian training and YR children enjoyed a road safety learning session. Many thanks to those of you who came and helped us run these events.

### Y1 phonics test/Y2 retake

This phonic reading test will take place for all Y1 children and any Y2 children who did not achieve the required standard last year during the week beginning 11<sup>th</sup> June. You need to ensure that as far as possible children attend school that week as the capacity for testing them after this is extremely limited and subject to strict rules. On no account should you take a term-time holiday during this period. Children who do not take the test, or who do not achieve the expected standard in Y1 will have to re-take the test next year. Y2 children who did not achieve the expected standard last year will take the test this week also. Results will be reported to you before the end of the summer term in your child's end of year report.

### Y2 assessment tests

These tests (SATs) in reading, writing and mathematics will take place during the week beginning May 21<sup>st</sup>. These are statutory and form part of teachers' assessment of children's final achievement level at the end of Y2. Children will take these tests in their classrooms during this week and so they need to be at school all week and on no account should you take a term-time holiday. It will not be possible for children to take the tests after this week. The results will be reported to you before the end of the summer term in your child's end of year report.
